15-48 FADDEN & ANDERSON & CARRIED that Township of Lake of the Woods calls on the Government of Ontario to stop the sale of any part of Hydro One, and maintain Hydro One Networks as a wholly owned public asset for the benefit of all Ontarians: and that this resolution be forwarded to the following: Hon Kathleen Wynne, Premier of Ontario, Hon Charles Sousa, Minister of Finance, Sarah Campbell MPPP and NOMA.

REC **15-49** FADDEN & ANDERSON & CARRIED that pursuant to the request of LOW Recreation, Council authorize a \$500.00 donation towards McCrosson-Tovell School swimming and other school activities.

OTHER The Rd Supt reported the plow truck needs a new rad and he is working on that, he has completed overhaul work on the grader, Vauthey Rd needs patching and gravel was placed at the end of the Gov't Dock ramp due to extremely low water on the lake (the complete opposite to last year), Road Patrol was held on April 15th, and the written report was circulated to Council. The monthly CBO report was received and reviewed with 5 permits being issued. The Fire Committee will meet on May 13th to review draft department guidelines. The Clerk-Treasurer updated Council on various items: including that the fire board meeting of April 8th, POA & OMPF funding receipts, a discussion on the minimum tax amount, the tax capping and tax ratios implications and a review of a draft for 2015 budget, an increase in the tax rate is required to meet increased cost especially the OPP & RRDSSAB levies this would be the first increase since 2004. The Rd Supt, the Clerk-Treasurer attended drainage training April 14-15 in Fort Frances. Mayor Pizey attended the recent NOMA convention. Upcoming training includes Note taking for Emergency Measures, annual emergency training & exercise in Barwick May 26 with some members of Council to attend, as well as the CEMC and Rd Supt and Fire Chief. CANWARN training will be held in Emo June 16th. The Clerk-Treasurer will discuss an extension agreement for a property presently under Tax Sale and the agreement will be presented to Council for their action. Dump fees will increase as well as the special charge for garbage collection within the Morson area.
